- Focus on fast and extensive scaling of their product or service.
- Look for organic and gradual growth.

#### Company Requirements

- A Danish CVR number.
- Fulfil the European Commission's definition of a SME.
- Min. DKK 100,000 in venture capital or development grants within the past three years, or
- A gross profit of min. DKK 250,000 within at least one of the last three published annual accounts.

#### An InnoBooster Project Focuses on

- Developing and maturing a new product or service.
- Improving a process within the company in an innovative way, significantly improving the company's competitiveness.

Projects holding greater technological risk and novelty value where the technical solution is developed is required.

#### Four Investment Themes

1. Green Technology and Innovation
2. Life Science, Health and Welfare Technology
3. Critical and Digital Technologies
4. Defence and Security Technology (Defence Tech Denmark)



#### The Funding Covers

- Hours for new and existing employees.
- Expenses for cooperation with public and private knowledge providers.
- Expenses for materials, renting equipment and depreciation on new equipment.

- 26 Mar - 13 May
- 27 May - 6 Aug
- 20 Aug - 15 Oct

#### Funding Rate

35% of all budget costs.

#### Duration

Up to 2 years.

# Inno booster Application

## Digital Application Form

Several text boxes outlining the company, idea, project, market potential, business potential and team.

## Activity Plan

Max. 5 pages to describe the development activities.

## E-grant

The online registration platform to submit the proposal which also contains basic information like contact details, turnover etc.

## Budget

An Excel document with the budget corresponding to the proposal.

## Illustrations

Max. one A4 page of illustrations that clearly demonstrates and supports how the new solution works.

## Video

Max. 2 minutes video that shows your team, idea and interest in the new solution.
